Choosing Your Business Structure

Sole Proprietorship

Simple structure, owner has unlimited personal liability.

Partnership

Shared responsibilities and liabilities, defined by agreement.

LLC

Offers liability protection and flexible management options.

Corporation

Complex structure with strong liability protection; includes S-Corp and C-Corp.



Required Documents: General

Articles of Incorporation/Organization

State-specific document establishing the company.

EIN (Employer Identification Number)

IRS tax ID necessary for federal tax filings.

Registered Agent Information

Legal contact with a physical address in the state.

Operating Agreement/Bylaws

Internal governance rules and ownership structure.



LLC-Specific Documents

Articles of Organization

Filed with Secretary of State to create the LLC.

Operating Agreement

Defines member roles and internal procedures.

LLC-1 Form

Required initial filing in some states like California.

Delaware LLC Certificate

Certificate of Formation required for Delaware LLCs.

Corporation-Specific Documents

Articles of Incorporation

Foundation document filed with Secretary of State.

Corporate Bylaws

Internal rules for officers and governance.

Stock Certificates

Proof of ownership issued to shareholders.

S-Corp Election (Form 2553)

File to elect S-Corp tax status with the IRS.

New York Certificate of Incorporation

Required for C-Corps in New York state.

EIN Application (IRS Form SS-4)



Online Application

Apply directly on the IRS website quickly and easily.



Requirement

Needed for all entities except most sole proprietorships.



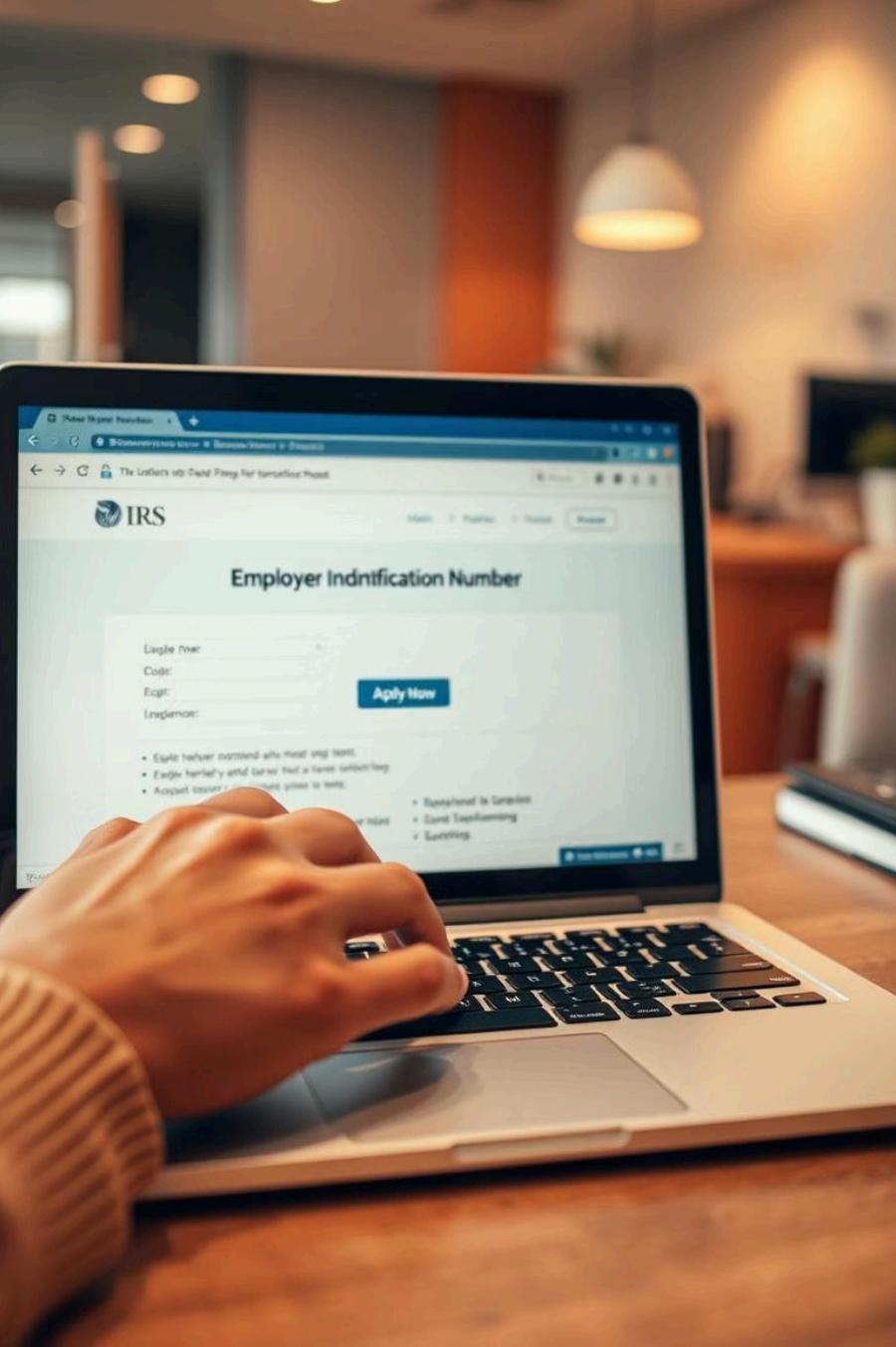
Purpose

Federal tax identification for payroll and tax reporting.



Cost

Free of charge; avoid costly third-party services.





State-Specific Requirements



Varied Rules

Each state has unique registration and licensing rules.



Licenses and Permits

Some states mandate special business licenses or permits.



Examples

- California: Statement of Information filing required.
- New York: Publication in newspapers is mandatory.



Staying Compliant



Annual Reporting

File annual reports and pay franchise taxes on time.



Registered Agent

Maintain a physical presence through your registered agent.



Consequences

Noncompliance risks penalties, fines, and possible dissolution.
